### What is it?

An estimated 18,000 elderly and disabled Kansans currently qualify but aren't enrolled in Medicare Savings Programs or "Extra Help." Both programs help make healthcare much more affordable. If you or your loved one are one of these people, enrolling is easy and professionals are available to help.

We believe that no older adult or person with disabilities in Kansas should ever have to go without their entitled benefits.

### Do I Qualify?

If you can answer **YES** to the following questions, you should apply.

- Do you have Medicare Part A, also known as hospital insurance?
- Are your annual resources at or below \$4,000 for an individual or \$6,000 for a married couple? Or, for Medicare Part D subsidy only, are your resources below \$12,510 for an individual or \$25,010 for a couple? **Resources do not include your primary residence and vehicle.**
- Is your income at or below the income limits found in the table below?

Medicare Savings Programs	Individual Monthly Income Limit*	Married Couple Monthly Income Limit*	The Medicare Savings Program May Pay Your:
Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB)	\$923	\$1235	Part A, Part B and Part D premiums, co-payments, deductibles and coinsurance
Low Income Medicare Beneficiary (LMB)	\$1103	\$1477	Part B premiums and Part D premiums, co-payments, deductibles and coinsurance
Expanded Low Income Medicare Beneficiary (ELMB)	\$1239	\$1660	Part B premiums and Part D premiums, co-payments, deductibles and coinsurance
Medicare Part D Subsidy (LIS)	\$1354	\$1821	Part D premiums, co-payments and deductibles
