- \* Unemployment compensation statements;
- \* SSA-1099 form if you were paid Social Security benefits;
- \* All 1099 forms showing interest and/or dividends & documentation showing original purchase price of sold assets;
- \* 1099-misc showing any miscellaneous income;
- \* 1099-R forms if you received a pension or annuity;
- \* All forms indicating federal income tax paid;
- \* Dependent care provider information (name, employer, ID, Social Security number);
- \* Receipts or cancelled checks if itemizing;
- \* Social Security cards or other documentation for yourself & all dependents.

Federal and state forms and instruction manuals are available at most banks, public libraries and County Clerk's offices.
